

INFORMATION NOTE ON sustainable tourism development – A project for the strengthening capacities for sustainable tourism development.

The project is being promoted by TrainForTrade programme of the United Nations Conference for Trade and Development (UNCTD)

The UNCTAD TrainForTrade programme was devised in 1998 to strengthen local capacities and foster national ownership in the field of trade and investment. In 2006 TrainForTrade put its capacity-development expertise available to the sustainable tourism sector and put forward its comprehensive approach. TrainForTrade is a demand-driven programme fostering collaborative mechanisms among all actors of the tourism value chain. TrainForTrade projects are integrated processes, using training, advisory services and technical assistance (for the formulation of micro projects) to accompany developing countries towards a sustainable tourism sector

The project targets training of the policy makers, local authorities and institutions to design, plan and implement sustainable tourism projects, as well as enhancing multi stakeholders' dialogue and participation in decision making
